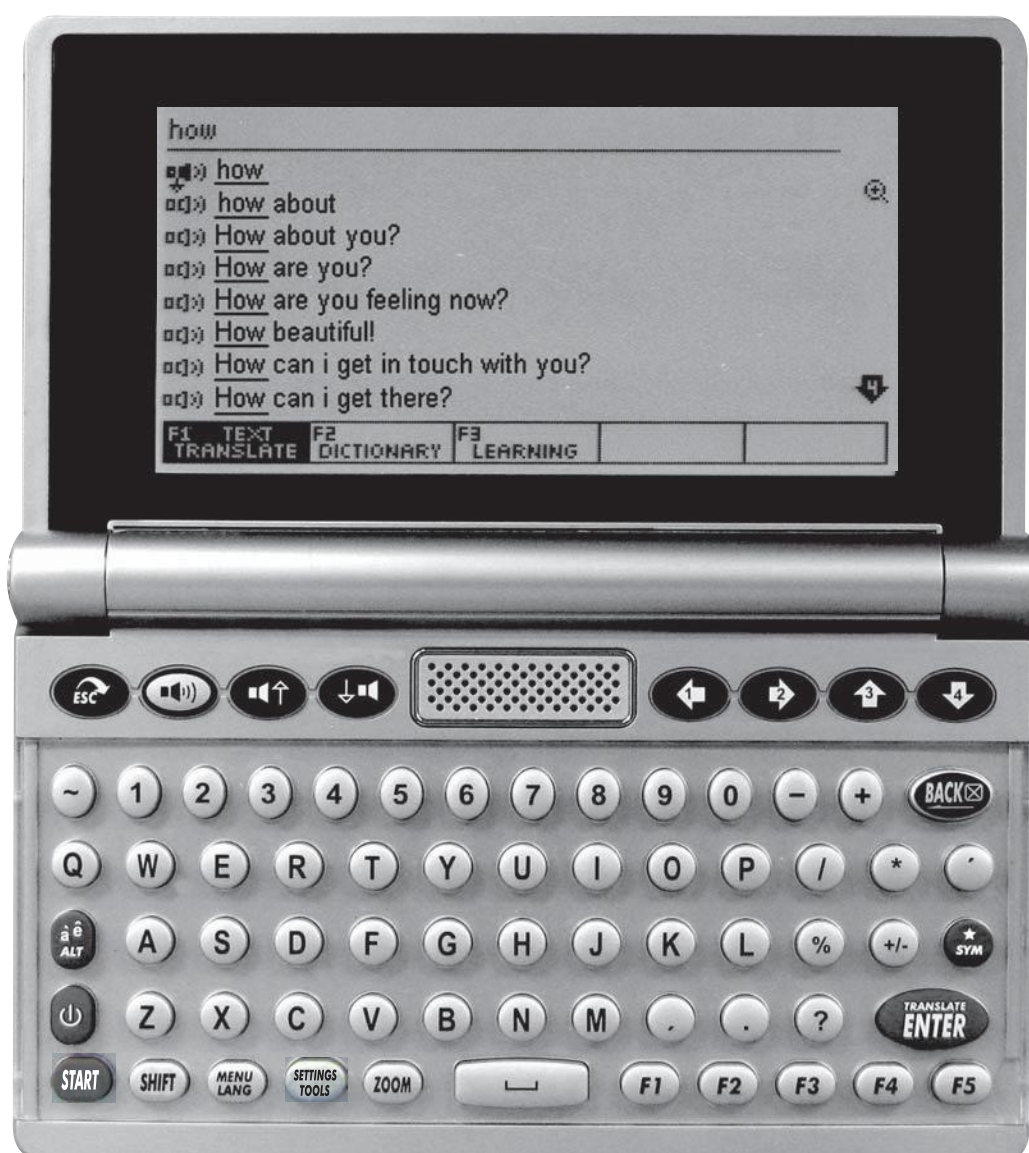

PRONUNCIATION KEYS

Speak Key

🔊 Press to hear pronunciation.

Line Up/Down

🔊 🔊 Line Up/Down or move to available voice option.

Alternate Pronunciation

⌨ + 🔊 Press ALT key and then SPEAK key, to hear Word by Word Computer Pronunciation instead of Human Pronunciation.

Voice Matching

⇧ + 🔊 Press SHIFT key and then SPEAK key, to record your pronunciation to match with the native speaker.

Adjust the Volume

⇧ + 🔊 Hold the SHIFT key and press 🔊 key, to set louder voice.

⇧ + 🔊 Hold the SHIFT key and press 🔊 key, to set lower voice.

Adjust the Voice Speed

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Power and Battery

- Use 2 PCs AAA Alkaline battery.
- Standby time: Up to 680 days.
- Non-stop use: Up to 15 hours.
- Audio playback: Up to 6.5 hours.
- DC use via compatible micro USB power adaptor or USB to computer system.

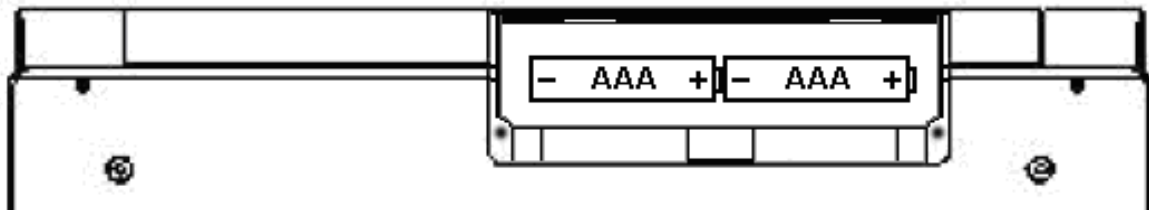
Power Source

- The translator is powered by 2 AAA Alkaline (non-rechargeable) batteries (included).
- The translator can also operate via USB, connected to PC/laptop. Note batteries will not be charged via USB.
- It can be operated via Micro-USB adapter (not included).
- When batteries power is low,  appear on display. If this happens, replace batteries.
- Turn off the translator before replacing batteries.
- Do not use different types of batteries or used batteries.
- Make sure batteries make good contact with the metal plates.
- Always remove a weak or dead battery from the device.
- If battery leaks, clean the battery compartment immediately, ensuring that battery fluid does not come into contact with skin.
- Do not expose batteries to direct heat.

Resetting the Translator

If the keyboard fails to respond, or if the screen performs erratically, you should reset the translator.

Remove the batteries. Put the batteries back after ~1 minute.



Note: To make sure any recent changes will not be lost (settings, favorites, etc), you must TURN OFF the device first before remove the batteries.

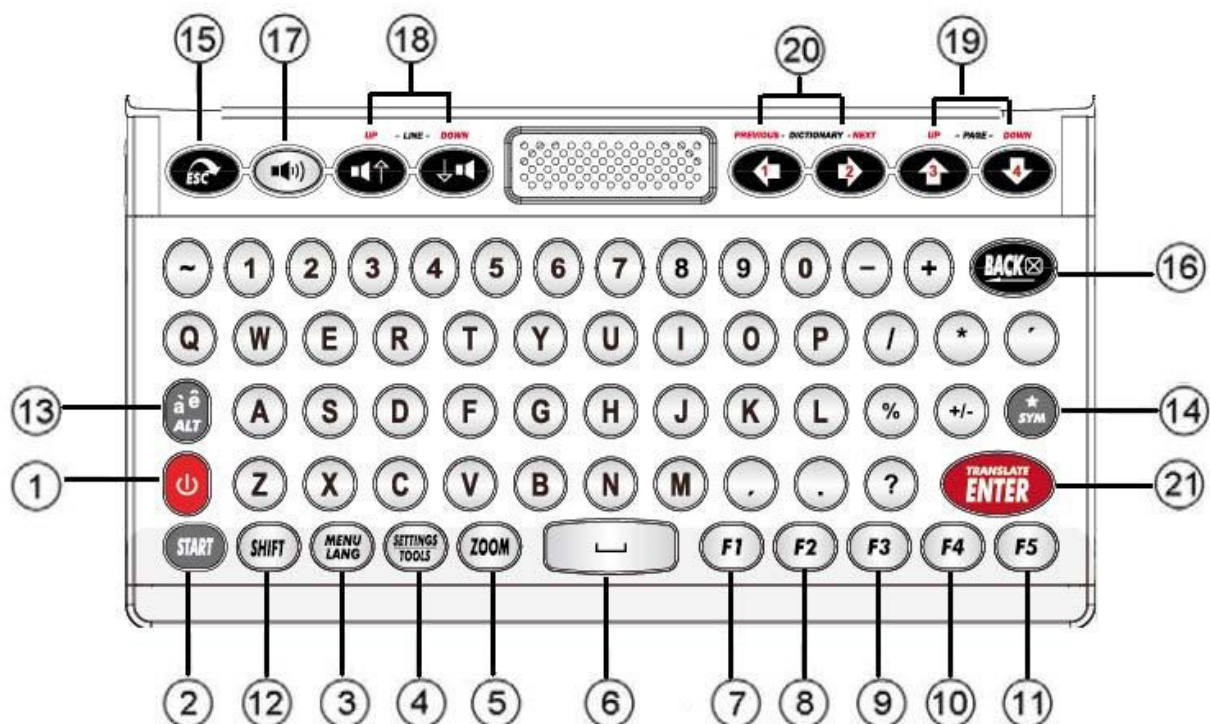
Micro-SD Card and USB (not included)








1. There is a Micro-SD cartridge on the side of the Translator. You can download the text files or update software (if any in future) from your computer to the SD card, insert the SD card to the Translator to read them.





Note: You must turn OFF the device first before you insert or remove the MSD card, otherwise the settings will not be saved.



2. The Translator can be connected to a computer via USB cable (USB cable not included). You are able to download text files or update software (if any in the future). This feature is only compatible with Microsoft Windows.


The function of keys





1.  : On/Off button. Translator has auto turn off function (3, 5, or 10 minutes). You can set the time under Tool → Shut off Time. Factory default is set to 5 minutes.
2.  : Start Menu. Select your translation language.
3.  : Language of interface. Press repeatedly to cycle through different languages.
4.  : Go to Settings to adjust the voice speed and LCD contrast, etc. Go to Tools to use the calculator and the unit conversion, etc.
5.  : Press repeatedly to cycle through different font sizes.
6.  : Space.
7.  : Text Translate.
 - a) This function allows you to type in both words and phrases.
 - b) Depending on the screen, this button's functionality may change. Refer to the bottom of the screen for details.


8.  : Dictionary.
a) This function allows you to look up single words at a time for a more detailed search.
b) Depending on the screen, this button's functionality may change. Refer to the bottom of the screen for details.
9.  : Learning.
a) Provides some tools and lessons for learning the specified language.
b) Depending on the screen, this button's functionality may change. Refer to the bottom of the screen for details.
10.  : Inflection/ Verb conjugation.
Depending on the screen, this button's functionality may change. Refer to the bottom of the screen for details.
11.  : Sample phrase.
Depending on the screen, this button's functionality may change. Refer to the bottom of the screen for details.

12.  : a) Capital letter. Press or Hold Shift then press a letter, this will get the capital of the letter.
b) In cross word translation, press or Hold shift key, then press down arrow key  to highlight two or more words.

13.  : a) àê- Accent key: Press target alphabet, and then press the Accent key to get available characters. E.g. Press 'o', then press the Accent key to get [ô, œ] etc.

Tips: While typing letters with the  key on translator keyboard, you have to press the

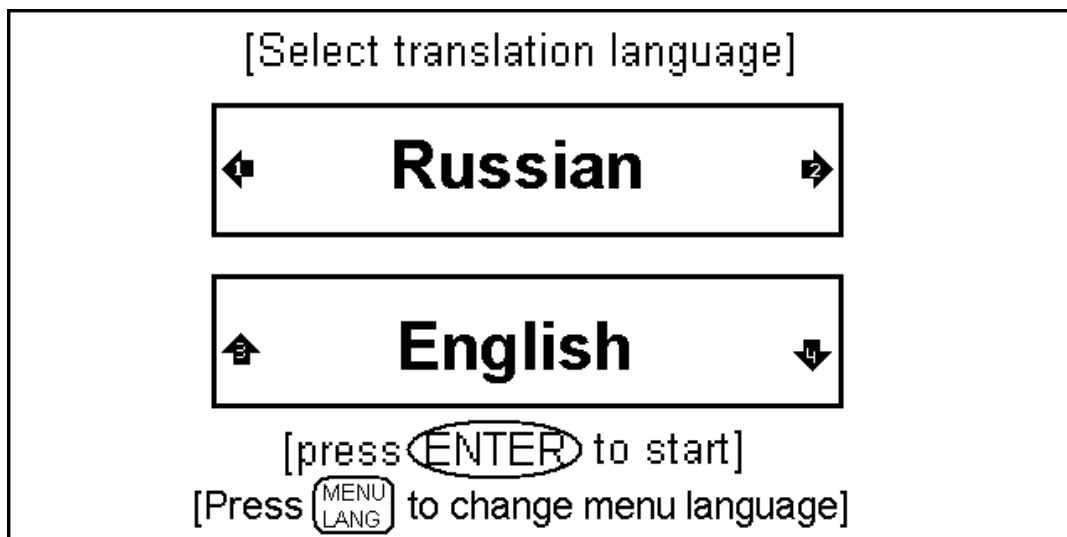
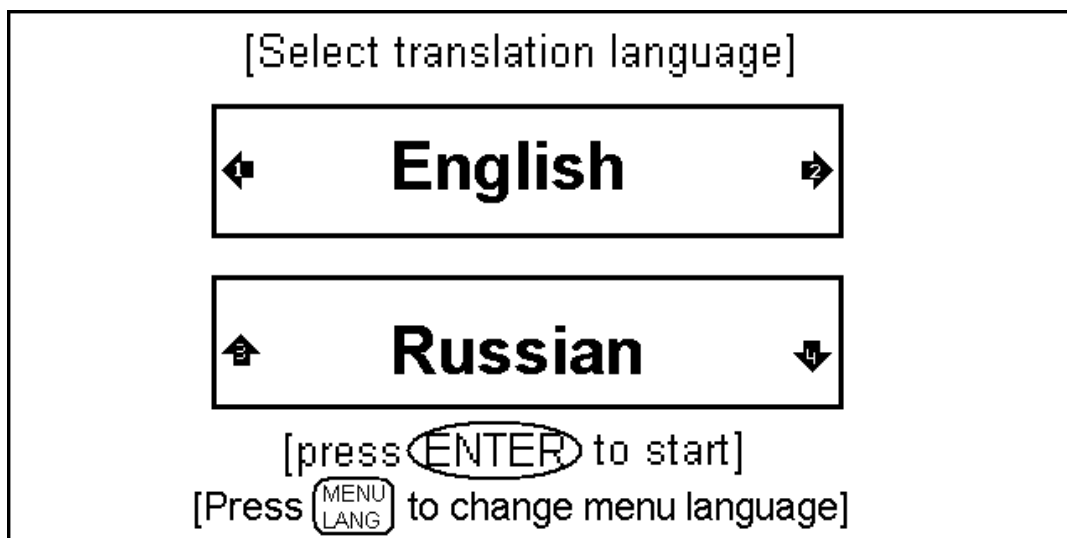
letter key once followed by the  key. For instance in the French model, on the the translator keyboard press the letter (A) once


(do not hold it down) then press  key to get "á".

b) ALT-alternative:


- i) Switch input method if available.
- ii) Switch speaker for computer voice.
- iii) Switch to get other alphabets.
- iv) Convert between two languages.

14.  : a) Symbol. Type punctuation, ./... ?*- Wildcard. More powerful searches can be done using placeholder symbols (?) (*) to search for unknown letters, e.g. 'AMA?ING' to find 'amazing'; 'AMAZ*' to find 'amaze' or 'amazing'.
- b) Favorites -- In Translate or Dictionary mode, use this button to add the current word or phrase to your list of favorites.

15.  : Escape, returns to previous screen.



16.  : Backspace, deletes the last input.



17.  : Speaker, press to hear pronunciation.

a) Voice Matching: Press and hold the SHIFT key, and use the  key to record your pronunciation to match with the native speaker.

b) Alternate Pronunciation:
Press the ALT key, followed by the  key.



You will hear the computer pronunciation, instead of the human pronunciation.


18.  /  : Move selection up and down to the next available voice option.


a) Adjust the volume by holding down the SHIFT key, then use the  /  keys to control the volume for the voice.

Use the SHIFT and  key to turn the volume up.



Use the SHIFT and  to turn the volume down.


b) Adjust the voice speed by holding down the ALT key, then use the  /  keys to control the speed which the voice is played.

Use the ALT and  key to make the speed faster.

Use the ALT and  key to make the speed slower.

19.  /  : Navigator up/down and Page up/Page down.

20.  /  : a) Left/ Right.
b) See next dictionary or previous dictionary in Dictionary List.

21.  : a) Enter key.
b) Select word.

Alphabet with Accents (Vowel)

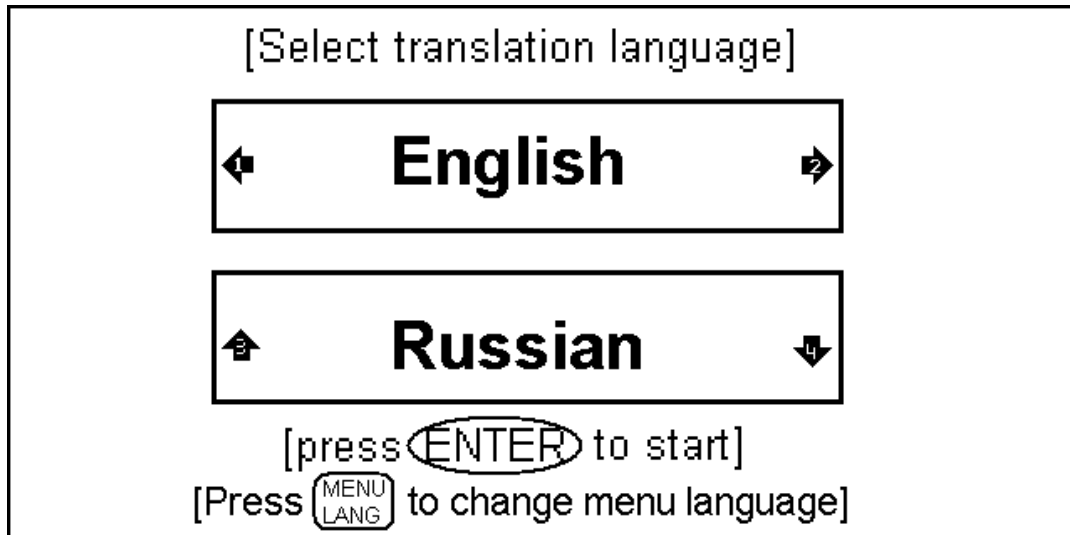

START MENU

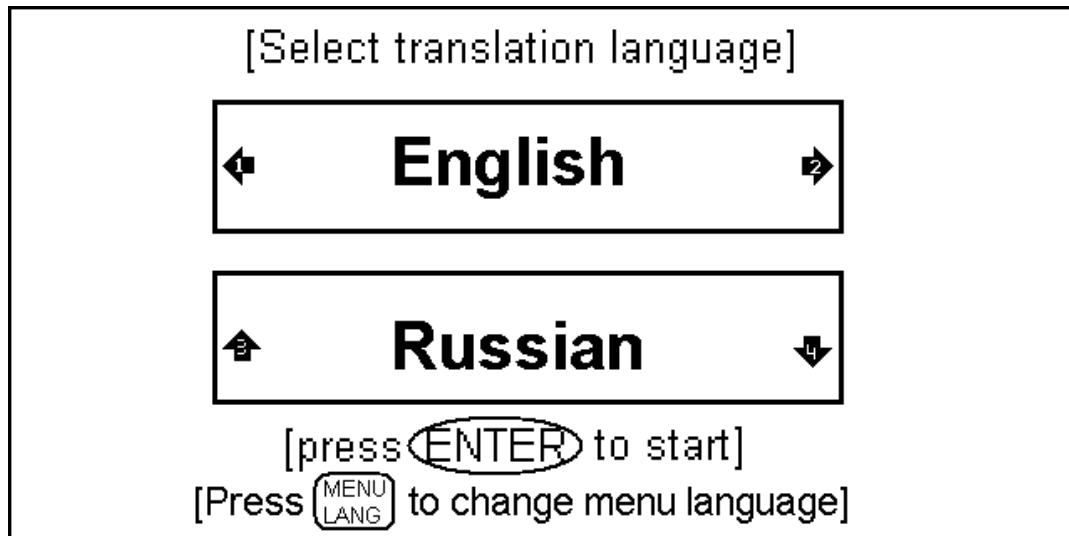
Press  to get the text menu.
e.g. English-Russian



1. Use  /  to choose source language. Use  /  to choose the target language and press .
2. The Start Menu can be switched to different modes in SETTINGS.
 - a) Under Tools, you can select – Set Start Menu.
 - b) You can now select Text Menu, Icon Menu, or both Text & Icon Menu.

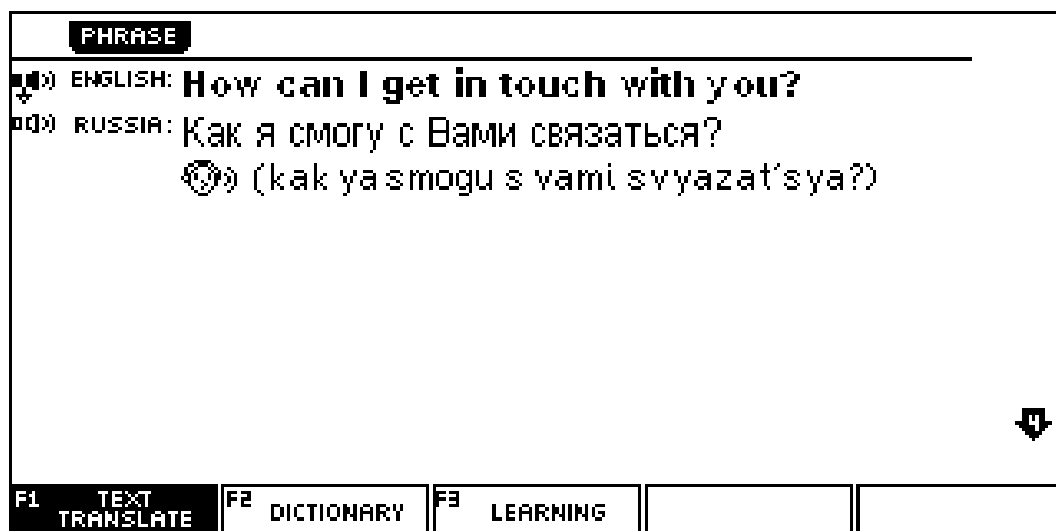
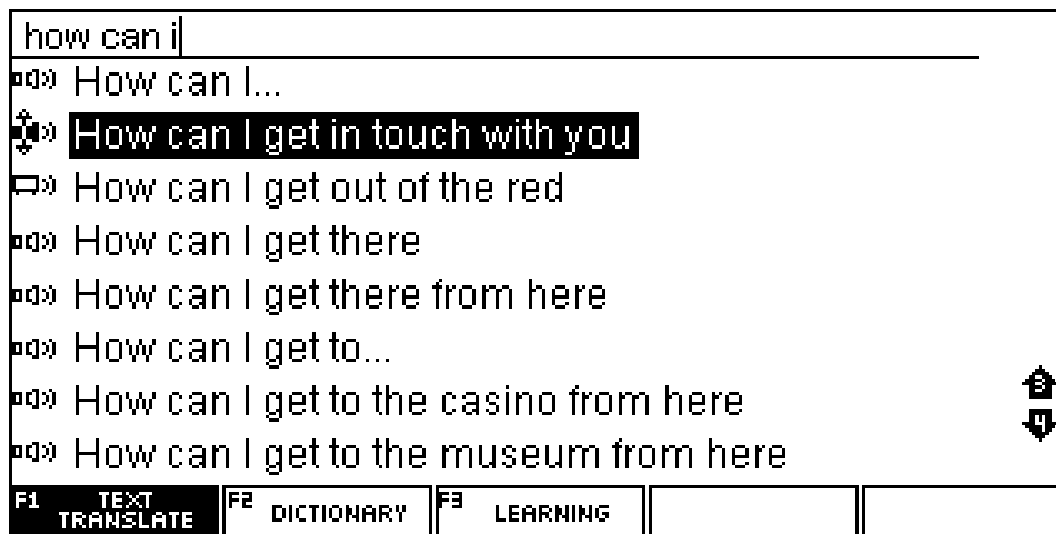

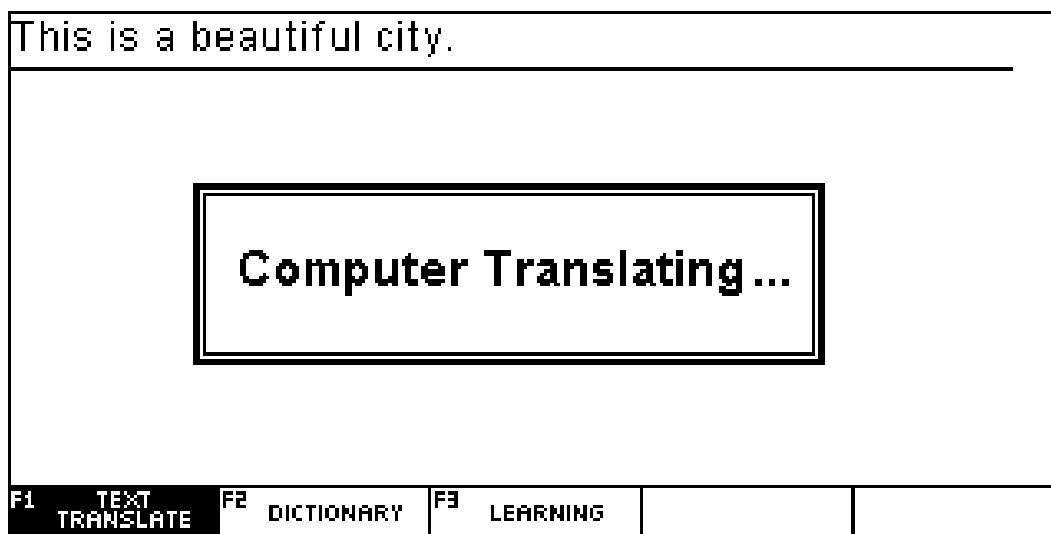
This device has a large built-in database of commonly used phrases.



- **Computer translation**

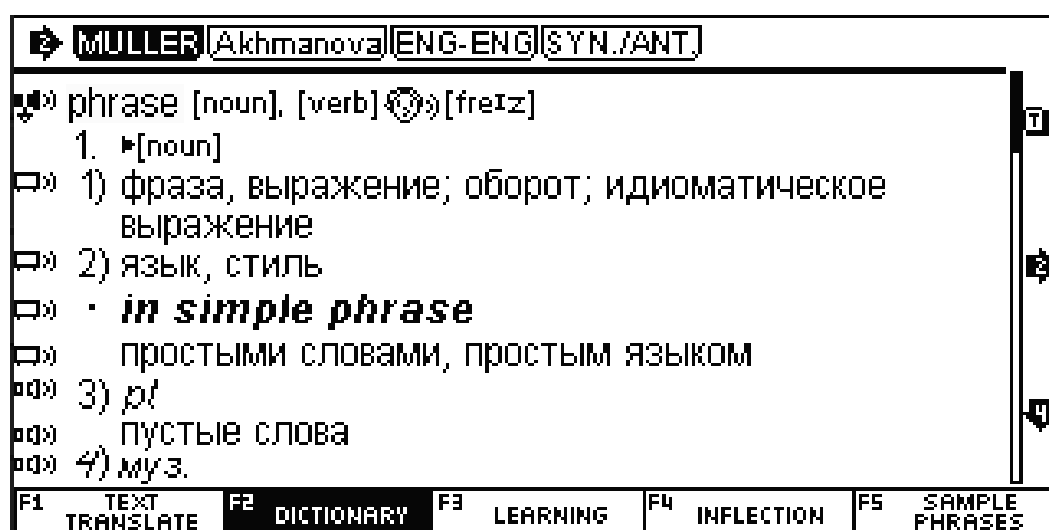
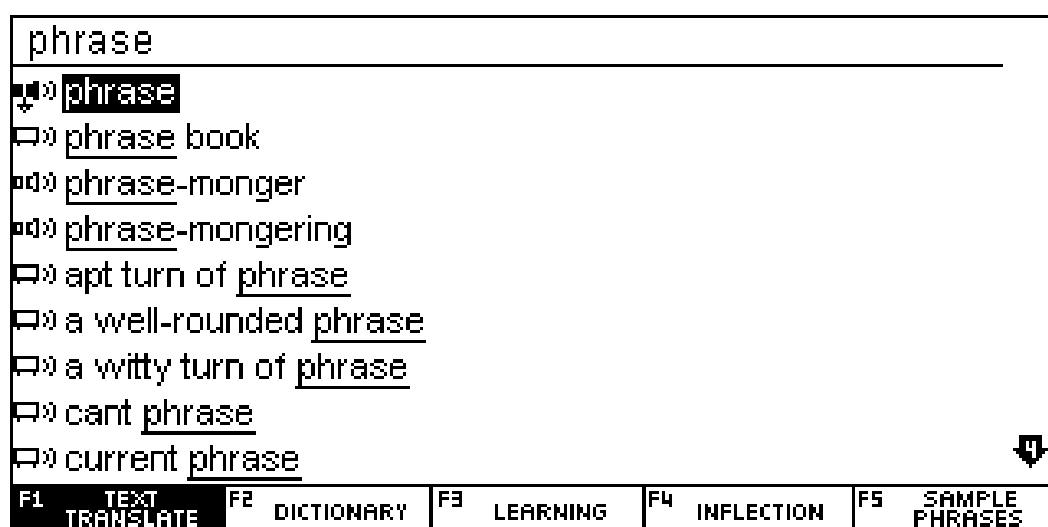
1. If the user does not type the phrase in the exact same way that it is listed in the database, or the database does not include a phrase, then the Computer will automatically generate a translation.

e.g.: This is a beautiful city

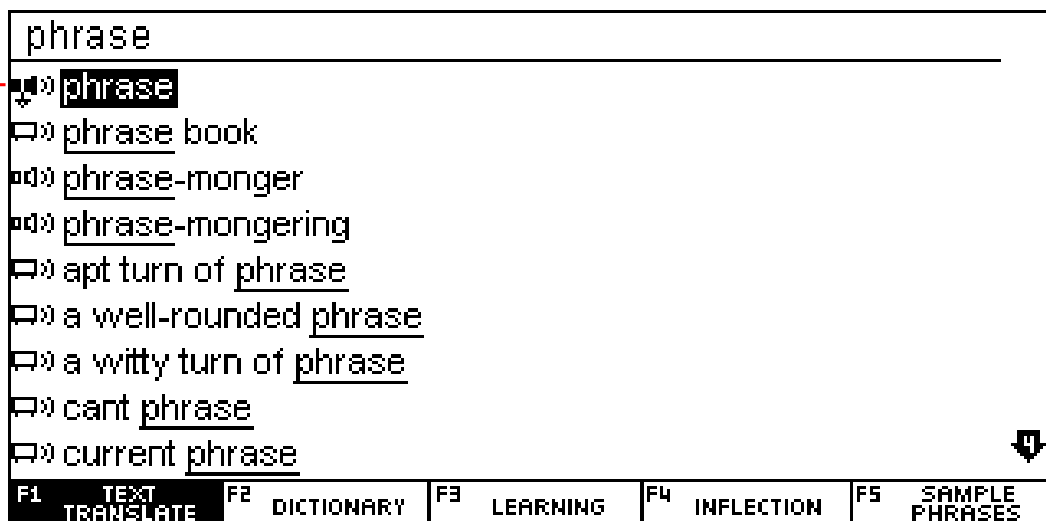






2. Since the translation is generated by computer, the result should be used as reference rather than exact translation.
3. If only a single word is entered, while the dictionary is operating in Text Translator mode, the product will automatically transfer to the Dictionary interface.

e.g.: phrase

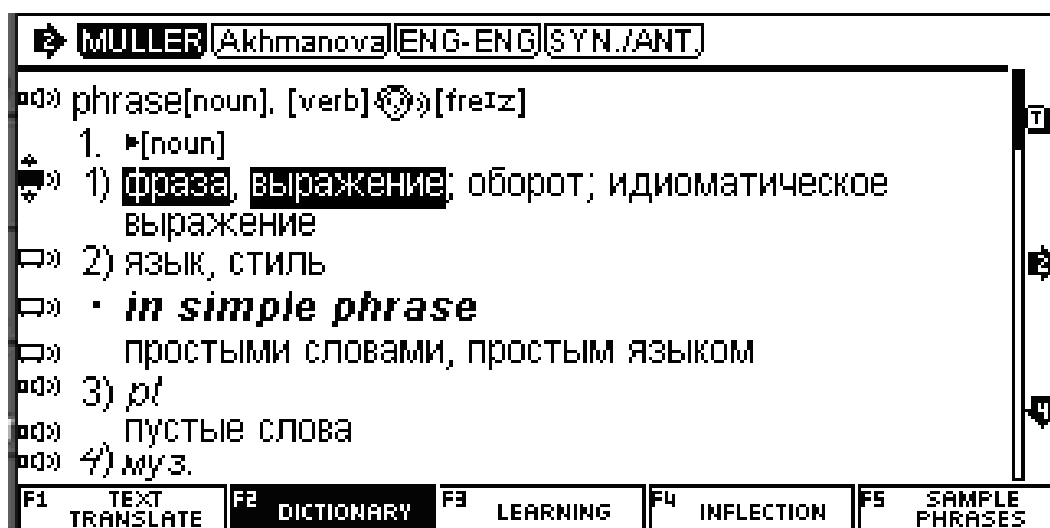


Pronunciation







- The speaker icon will show in front of words that have human audio recordings.
- The speaker icon will show in front of words that have computer audio recordings.
- Press the pronunciation arrow keys ( / ) to move the sound icon up/down. Then press the  key to hear the pronunciation.
- To hear the pronunciation of one or more words, 'highlight' the words, then press the  key.





e.g.:



• How to Highlight Words

- a) In the definition screen, press the  key.
- b) Use the  /  keys to move the highlighted selection to the word that you want.
- c) To highlight two or more words, press and HOLD the shift key, then press the  key.

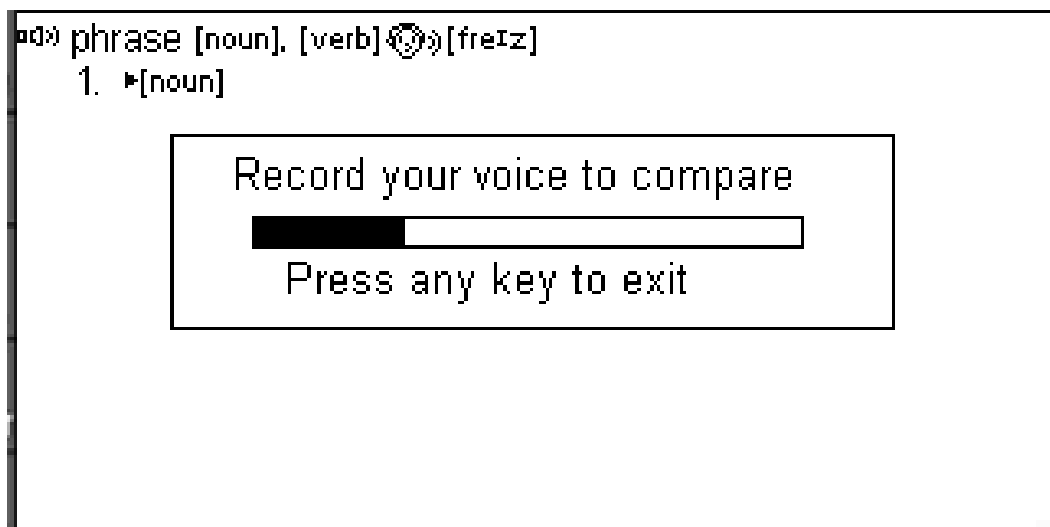
• Pronunciation icons

Voice Matching (Record and Play-Back)

This feature provides a good way to practice pronunciation.

Press and hold the SHIFT key, then use the  key.



First, the original pronunciation will play. Then the screen will notify you when the recording will start. When you have finished repeating the phrase, press any key to stop the recording. Both pronunciations will play back automatically.

Alternate Pronunciation

If a Human Pronunciation is available for a phrase, this function allows the user to listen to the Computer Pronunciation, rather than the normal Human Pronunciation.

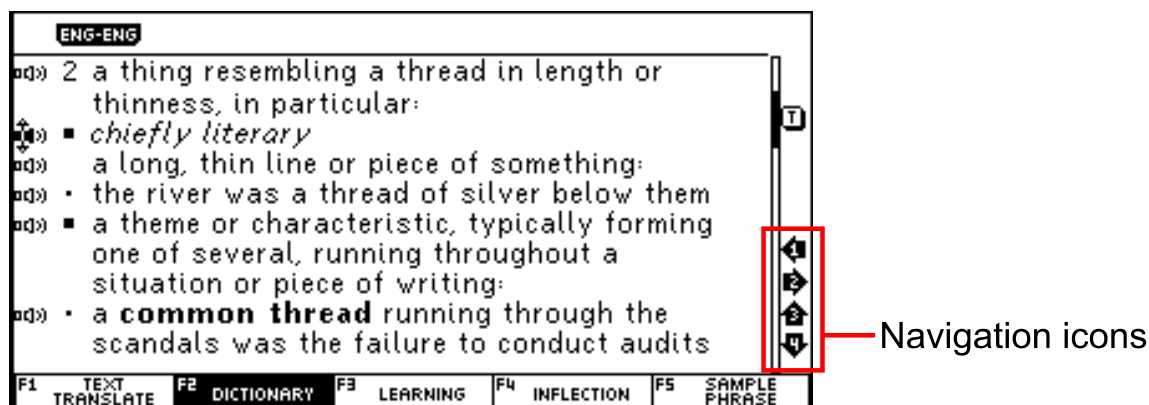
The Computer Pronunciation provides a slower pace by separately pronouncing each individual word in the phrase. This feature can help ones to clearly distinguish the correct pronunciation for each word.


E.g. Enter the phrase: "How can I get in touch with you?"

Press the ALT key, followed by the  key. You will hear the Computer Pronunciation, instead of the Human Pronunciation.



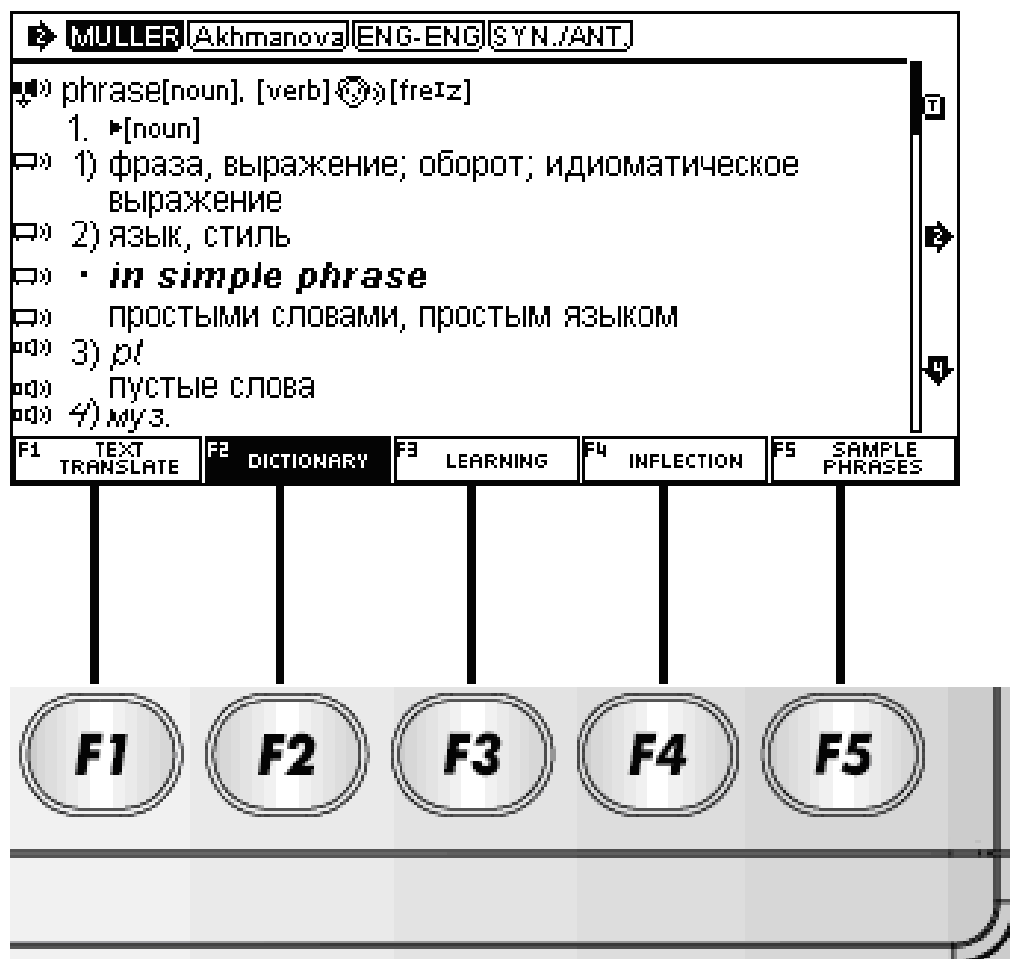

Pop-up

Favorites/History Menu



- After entering a word or text, press  to enter definition view.
- In the definition view, the  can be pressed to enter the Favorites menu.
- From this menu you can use the Up/Down keys to select Add to Favorites, Show All Favorites or Show All History. (See Settings)

How to Highlight Words

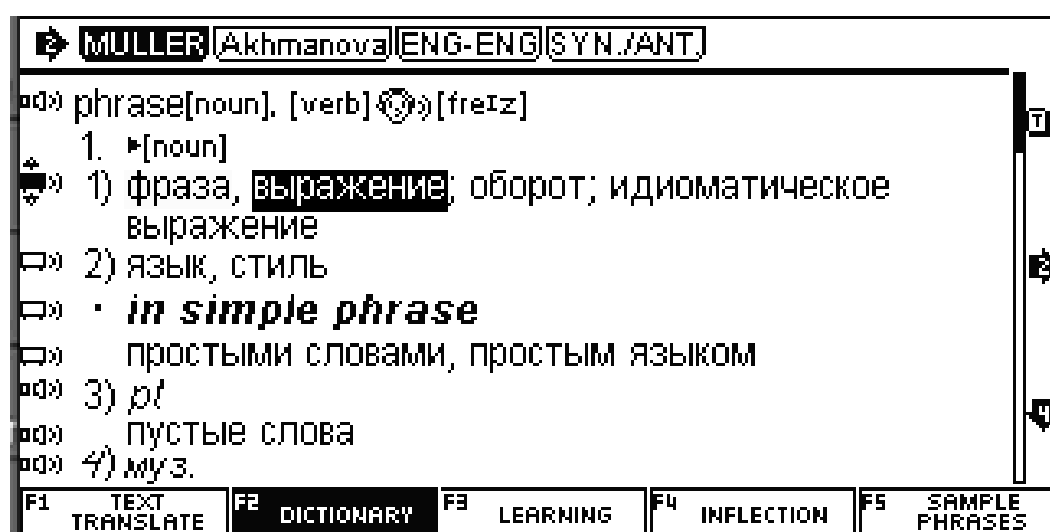
- a) If you want to cross search or hear the voice with the specific word, you can highlight the words.
- b) In the definition screen, press the  key.
- c) Use the  /  keys to move the highlighted selection to the word that you want.
- d) To highlight two or more words, press and HOLD the shift key, then press the  key.

Cross Search

This function allows you to select words in the definition view and look them up in different language dictionaries installed on your device. To do this, follow the following steps:

In the definition screen, press  . Then highlight any word and press  again to view other language dictionaries for this word.

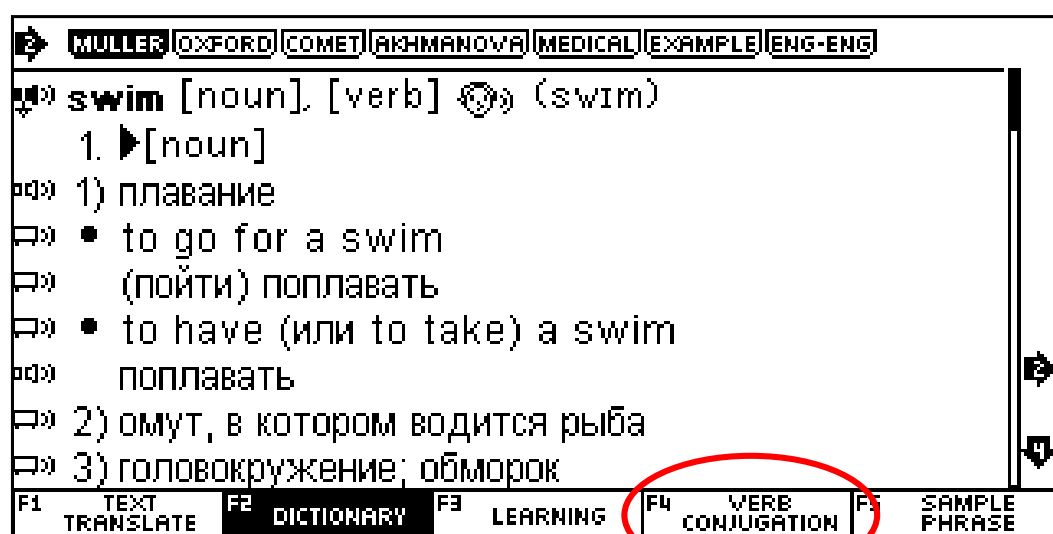

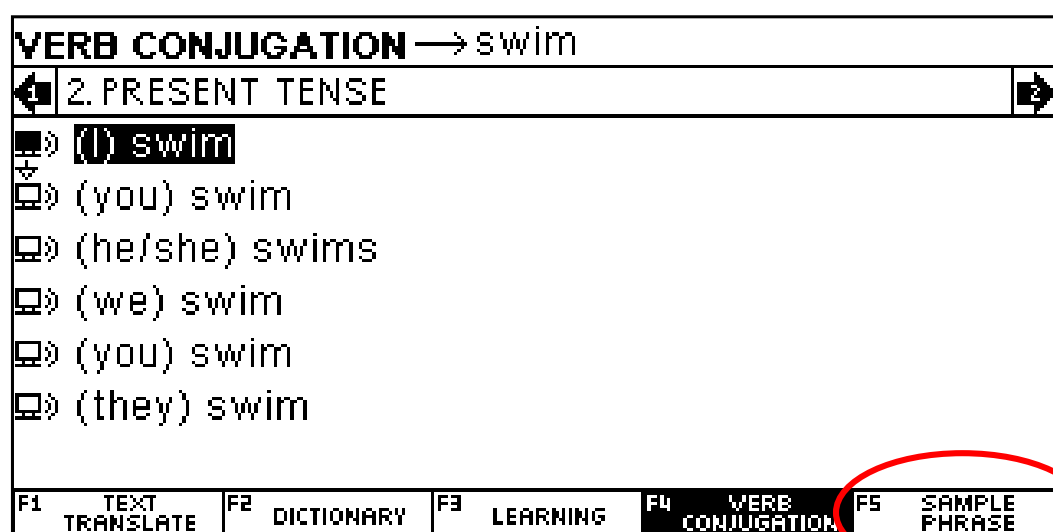

Wildcard characters

You can search for a word directly, which will simply list all the words containing the given root word. However, a more detailed search can be done by using 'place-holder symbols' to define a search pattern.

? = any unknown letter

* = more unknown letter

For example: 'AMA?ING' to find 'amazing';
'AMAZ*' to find 'amaze' or 'amazing'.

Convert Number to Text

When using English in FI Text Translate mode, you can type in numbers to instantly get the text translation of that number in English.

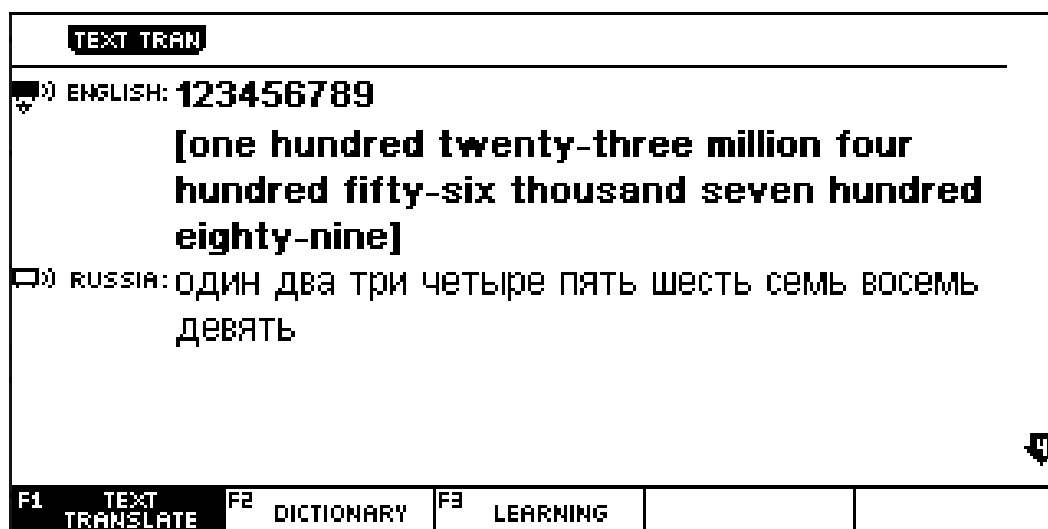
This function is very useful for learning how to say large series of numbers in English.

You can then translate the English translation into another language. This is a very a convenient way to learn how to speak basic numbers in other languages.

E.g. Using English and in Text Translate mode,
type: 123456789

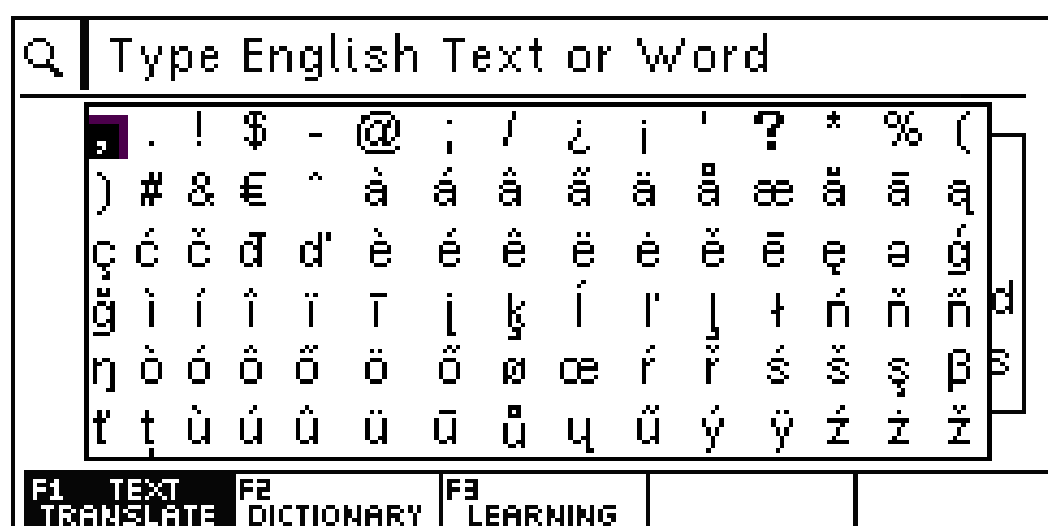
The screen will instantly show the result: one hundred twenty-three million four hundred fifty-six thousand seven hundred eighty-nine.

Press ENTER to show the number in the other language.

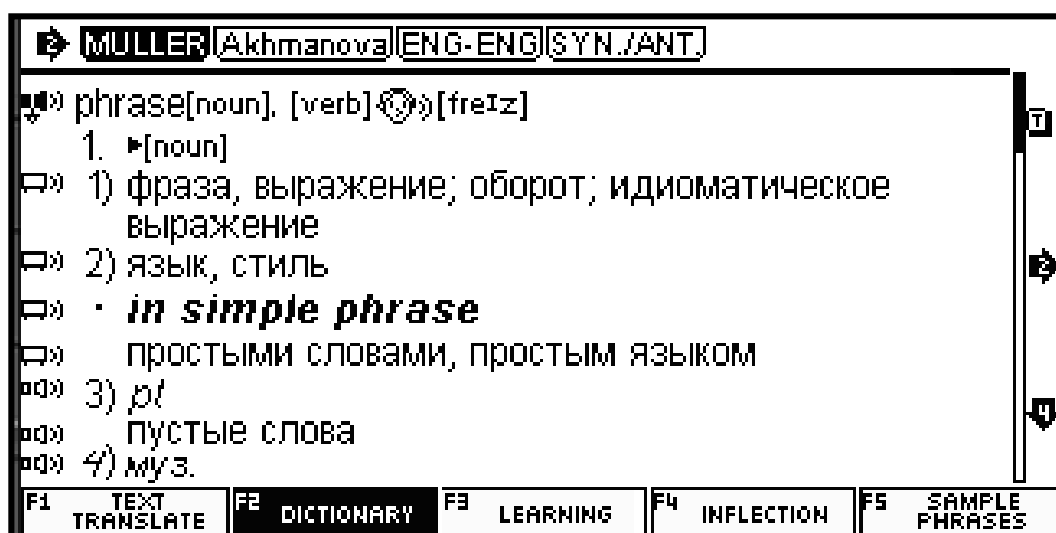




2. DICTIONARY (F2)

The Dictionary function, unlike the Text Translator function, is a more direct way to quickly and easily look up single words at a time. It will automatically list other single words that are related to the word that is typed, but it will not list other phrases or sentences.




This is clear and direct word search method makes this function ideal for checking spelling.






1. Press  to get into 'Dictionary' mode.
2. Type a word into the lookup screen. The screen will list related words to the word typed.
3. Use the arrow keys to choose the desired word and press  to see the definition.



4. Press  /  to view other dictionaries in the Dictionary List.

3. LEARNING (F3)

Press F3 to enter the 'Learning' mode. Use the  /  and then the  key to make your desired selection. This will open up the features for the selected category.

Add Language (Language Pack, available in some models)

TOOLS

Calculator

12 digit scientific calculator does standard arithmetic operations, calculates percentages, makes transactions with memory usage and operations of mathematical functions. To enter the calculator mode press [TOOLS] and select Calculator and the type of calculator: Standard or Scientific and press the [ENTER] key.

1. Standard calculator

a) Standard calculations are made by corresponding keys +, -, ×, ÷. Input numbers are shown in the right part of the display, arithmetic operators - in the left. Press key [+/-] to change the sign. To see the result press key [=].

b) Memory calculations

[M+] to add the total to the value in memory.

[M-] to subtract the total from the value in memory.

[MR] to recall or display the value in memory.

[MC] to clear the memory.

Note: Value, stored in the memory is shown at the upper display line.

c) Functional keys:

[F1] - Special functions (square root, logarithm, etc.)

[F2] - Switching between Degrees / Radians / Grads

[F3] - Memory reset

[F4]- Clears the last entered number.

2. Scientific calculator

The scientific calculator can perform both simple and more complex calculations.



Perform standard calculations the same way you would in the standard calculator. For more complex equations, this calculator allows you to input an entire equation.

Unit Conversion



1. Unit Conversion




Contains many kinds of measuring units, such as area, length, weight, speed, radian, cubage, power, caloric, pressure and temperature. This function provides two-way conversion among all units. International clothing sizes are also built-in for conversion.




1.1 To enter Unit Conversion mode press the TOOLS key → Unit Conversion.

1.2 With the help of the arrows  /  select required measurement and press the [ENTER] key to enter the corresponding menu.

1.7 Press the [ESC] key to return to the last menu.

2. Size

2.1 This menu provides conversion charts for Men/Women's clothing/shoe sizes. There are four international sizes provided.







2.2 The operating principle for this function is similar to the Unit Conversion function: Use the arrow keys  /  to make your selection and press the [ENTER] key to view the corresponding information and confirm.

Currency Conversion

1. Press  /  key to choose the currency.
2. Press  key to set the exchange rate, input the exchange rate, and press ENTER.
3. Press  key and then press  key to set the currency.
4. Use Up/Down arrow keys to switch between two currencies, and enter a number to see the result.
5. Press the number keys to input the amount of money to convert.
6. To delete the amount, press the  key.

Time Conversion

This function allows you to set local and world time:

1. Press key [TOOLS] -> Time conversion -> and with the help of the arrow  /  keys, choose the City1 and City 2.
Press  /  or  key to select city.
2. Use [F1] key to turn daylight saving time ON or OFF.
3. Use the  key to edit the time.

My Recorder

The Electronic Translator has a Dictaphone. From the [TOOLS] menu, select My Recorder to run it.
